

# Norman Jacobs Environment Scholarship

**Purpose:** to honour the life long contributions of Norm Jacobs to post secondary education at Six Nations while providing financial support to a successful Six Nations post secondary student enrolled in an environmental study or related program at the college or university level. Examples of eligible programs are:

forestry, environmental policy, environmental law, environmental conservation, ecologically sound architecture, irrigation and water management, land and natural resources, water science, wildlife, fisheries, and forest conservation and/or management, aquaculture, natural sciences, plant sciences, and botany.

**Amount:** \$1,000

**Deadline:** Applications must be received by Grand River Post Secondary Education Office (GRPSEO) by Aug 1. Please note: a recipient of the scholarship may apply to receive the award in subsequent years.

**Eligibility:** Open to successful Six Nations post secondary students who have successfully completed one year of study in an eligible program as outlined in the purpose of the scholarship. The student must plan to continue in the eligible program of study.

**To apply:** Submit the following by August 1<sup>st</sup> to the Grand River Post Secondary Education Office

1. A one page biography that includes:
  - your program, year of study, and the institution you attend,
  - how you see your responsibilities to Mother Earth,
  - how you uphold them, and
  - how your education will contribute to a better environment for future generations.
2. Your transcript that verifies you have successfully completed one year of study in an eligible program for this scholarship.
3. Your next semester registration or other evidence of your intent to continue in your program of studies.
4. Proof of Six Nations membership if you are not being funded through the GRPSEO.

The GRPSEO reserves the right to publish the recipient name and biography as a condition of issuing the scholarship funds.

A selection committee will review all applicants. A member of Norman Jacobs' family participates in the selection process.

The scholarship is administered by the GRPSEO.
