Six Nations of the Grand River Development Corporation (SNGRDC) is honoured to be recognized for the second year in a row by Deloitte Canada as a Best Managed Company.

This is one of Canada's leading business award programs, which recognizes Canadian companies for business excellence. Best Managed applicants are evaluated based on four key areas which include: Strategy, Capability, Commitment, and Financials. SNGRDC was slated to participate in the Best Managed Gala on April 1 in Toronto, however the event was cancelled as a result of COVID-19.

SNGRDC's business model is built on the pillars of transparency and accountability to its beneficiary – the people of the Six Nations of the Grand River. SNGRDC has a unique governance and community benefit structure in which surplus profits generated by SNGRDC are invested back into the collective

benefit of the Six Nations community through: 1) Distributions to the Economic Development Trust (with over \$10.8 million invested since 2016); 2) Capital Investments into community owned infrastructure (with over \$5 million invested since 2015); and 3) Equity Investment in financially sound projects which will bring in additional revenues to the community.
