***Correction: Economic Development Trust Announces
\$502K in Additional Funding for 2024 Applicants***

For Immediate Release: March 28, 2024 – On March 18, 2024, the Six Nations of the Grand River Economic Development Trust (EDT) announced that additional funding was available for 2024 applicants. The amount available that was announced in this press release was incorrect due to a calculation error.

The EDT is pleased to announce the revised amount available for community investment in 2024 is \$502,300. This is surplus funding that was not previously allocated as part of the first 2024 call for EDT applications.

Applications are now available online at www.sixnationsedt.ca. The final application deadline is May 3, 2024, at 4:00pm.

Those who were successful in obtaining funding in the first call for 2024 applications are not eligible to re-apply. Applicants are encouraged to take advantage of the pre-screening process, which allows applications to be reviewed prior to the final deadline to ensure that all sections are completed, and all proper documentation is included to give applicants the greatest chance of success. The pre-screening is available until April 19, 2024, at 4:00pm. For any questions regarding application pre-screening, please reach out to trust@sndevcorp.ca.

Applicant presentations will take place in the Six Nations of the Grand River Development Corporation (SNGRDC) boardroom on June 29, 2024. All successful applicants will be notified on July 5, 2024.

Since 2016, the EDT has invested over \$18 million into the Six Nations community. The EDT funding is made possible through annual distributions of surplus profits from SNGRDC. For more information on the EDT, including application guidelines and past recipients, please visit www.sixnationsedt.ca.

About the Economic Development Trust

The Economic Development Trust (EDT) is the mechanism in which surplus profits generated by Six Nations of the Grand River Development Corporation (SNGRDC) are invested into the Six Nations community for the collective benefit of its members. This model of distribution was a direct result of the 2011 community engagement study “We Gather Our Voices”. Following the launch of SNGRDC’s newly remodeled governance structure in March 2023, the mandate of the EDT has become a function of the SNGRDC Board of Directors, which will continue to provide funding for community investment.
